



Europe's share of global GDP is shrinking



Europe represents a falling share of the world population



The euro is now a global currency but other players are gaining weight





- Single Market is under pressure: free movement of workers and capital, provision of services
- Economic crisis is not over: unemployment, imbalances, inequalities
- Globalisation increasingly questioned: trade agreements, investor protection, trade defence / protection
- Negative perception of European Union



- 60 years of peace \rightarrow stability, prosperity and welfare
- Main player at global level → single European countries will be irrelevant
- European structural and investment funds
- Single market is main driver for growth & jobs
- Single currency \rightarrow manage exchange rate risks
